



What are my options?

Our belief is that everyone should have an end-of-life plan that meets their personal, emotional and spiritual needs. You can request the kind of care you want by completing an Advance Health Care Directive.

Medical Aid in Dying (MAiD) eligibility

- Diagnosed with a terminal disease, with a life expectancy of six months or less, by two physicians
- 18 years or older
- Sound mind and exhibit appropriate decision-making capabilities to the attending physician
- Able to self-ingest the medication either orally or by pushing through an NG tube

Other options

- Voluntarily Stopping Eating and Drinking (VSED)
- Refusing unwanted medical treatment
- Hospice and Palliative Care
- Palliative Sedation
